Grapes: *Blocks #1, 2, & 3 from our Philo Vineyard in Anderson Valley. Clone selection: Pommard, Swan, 113, 115, & 777*

Harvest: *Hand-picked September 14th, 2013. Harvest Stats (averages): 26.7 brix, 0.51 TA, 3.87 pH*

Production: *Morning loads only, stemmed and lightly crushed with 50% remaining as whole berries. Average cold soak for 6 days. 16 days on the skins and double racked to all French oak. 18 months in barrel mix, 34% new French oak.*

TASTING NOTES:

Our single vineyard Pinot Noir, which is grown in the warm days and foggy evenings of the Anderson Valley, opens with aromas of mint leaf and rose petals. Bright strawberry and plum flavors lead into allspice in the middle and a long Christmas spice finish.
