CONTENTO VINEYARD n ESTATE BOTTLED

Grapes: *Contento Vineyard, Hopland, CA, Mendocino*
Harvest: *Harvested on October 14th, 2013. Degree brix at harvest: 27.4.*
Production: *Morning loads, stemmed and lightly crushed with 50% remaining as whole berries. Cold soak for 48 hours prior to fermentation. In temperature controlled tanks, pumped over 2-3 times a day. Individual lots remained on the skins for an average of 18 days. Pressed to tank, ML inoculated, settled for 24-72 hours, racked to barrels. 50%/50% French and American oak, in 30% new oak. Barrel aged for 18 months.*
