GRAPES: *Blocks #1, 2 & 3 from our Philo Vineyard in Anderson Valley. Clone selection: Pommard,, 115, & 777*

HARVEST: *Hand-picked on September 1st, 2016. Harvest Stats (averages): 25.6 brix, 0.51 TA, 3.73 pH*

PRODUCTION: *Morning loads only, de-stemmed with 50% remaining as whole berries. Average cold soak for 6 days. 16 days on the skins and double racked to all French oak. 18 months in barrel mix, 25% new French oak.*

TASTING NOTES:
