Candelabra takes its name from the majestic redwood trees that form the western edge of the Anderson Valley. A candelabra is a fallen Redwood that sends new shoots upward and continues to grow and preserve its heritage for generations. Our father had the foresight to develop this property in the beautiful and remote Anderson Valley in 1991. Just as the Coastal Redwoods thrive on the fog of the Valley, so too do the Pinot Noir grapes in the vineyard. The next generations of the Brutocao Family have chosen to honor his legacy with this wine.

GRAPES: Block #2 & 3 from our Philo Vineyard in Anderson Valley.Clone selection: Pommard, Swan, 115, 113 & 777

HARVEST: Hand-picked September 10th. Harvest Stats: 26.0 Brix, 0.48 TA, 3.80 pH

PRODUCTION NOTES: Vineyard selection wine, handpicked between 1am and 6 am in Morning in ½ ton bins. At the winery, hand sorted and de-stemmed directly into 1 ton fermentors with 50% remaining as whole berries, 10% whole clusters. Average cold soak for 48 hours hand punch downs only. 16 days on the skins and lightly presses to all French oak barrels. 24 months in barrel mix, 40% new French oak.

Aromas of currants, Bing cherry & cola, with Christmas spice greet you in this Anderson Valley Estate Pinot Noir. This then takes you to the long lush finish with all that fruit coming back through.

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
